This announcement is made by Beijing Enterprises Environment Group Limited (the “**Company**”) pursuant to Rule 13.09(2)(a) of Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on the Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the “**Listing Rules**”) and the Inside Information Provisions (as defined in the Listing Rules) under Part XIVA of the Securities and Futures Ordinance (Chapter 571 of the Laws of Hong Kong).

The board of directors (the “**Board**”) of the Company would like to inform the shareholders of the Company (the “**Shareholders**”) and potential investors that on 10 October 2025, the Company formed an unincorporated joint venture (the “**Joint Venture**”) with two construction companies in Chinese Mainland and Hong Kong, and the Joint Venture has submitted a tender for the Contract for the Integrated Waste Management Facilities Phase 2 (“**I·Park 2**”) (Contract No. EP/SP/312/24) awarded by the Environmental Protection Department of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (the “**HK Government**”).

I·PARK 2 promotes the various waste reduction and recycling initiatives of the HK Government, and contributes towards achieving the goals of “Zero Landfill” and carbon neutrality set out in the Waste Blueprint for Hong Kong 2035 and Hong Kong's Climate Action Plan 2050. The scope of the contract comprises the design, construction, operation and maintenance of I·PARK 2, located at the middle ash lagoon at Tsang Tsui, Tuen Mun, to treat 6,000 tonnes per day of municipal solid waste using moving grate incineration technology. The contract is scheduled to commence in early 2026. In addition to the design and construction works, the contract includes the operation and maintenance of I·PARK 2 for a period of 15 years.

Depends on the HK Government's tender evaluation results, the Joint Venture's bid for the contract of I-PARK 2 may or may not be successful. Shareholders and potential investors are advised to exercise caution when dealing in shares of the Company.
