CHANGE OF COMPANY NAME

The Board is pleased to announce that the change of the name of the Company from “TONIC INDUSTRIES HOLDINGS LIMITED” to “China Merchants Land Limited 招商局置地有限公司” became effective on 1 November 2013.

CHANGE OF STOCK SHORT NAME

The certificate of registration of change of corporate name of non-Hong Kong company was issued by the Registrar of Companies in Hong Kong on 21 November 2013. The shares will be traded on the Stock Exchange under the new stock short name of “CHIMER LAND” in English and “招商局置地” in Chinese with effect from 9:00 a.m. on 29 November 2013. The stock code of the Company remains as “978”.

CHANGE OF COMPANY WEBSITE

The website of the Company will be changed to ir.cmland.hk with effect from 26 November 2013 to reflect the change of company name.

Reference is made to the circular of Tonic Industries Holdings Limited (the “Company”) dated 10 June 2013 (the “Circular”) in relation to, inter alia, the proposed change of name of the Company and the proposed amendments to the existing memorandum and articles of association of the Company. Unless the context otherwise requires, capitalised terms used herein shall have the same meanings as those defined in the Circular.

CHANGE OF COMPANY NAME

The Board is pleased to announce that following the passing of the special resolution in relation to the change of company name at the EGM held on 2 July 2013 and the Closing on 1 November 2013, the change of name of the Company from “TONIC INDUSTRIES HOLDINGS LIMITED” to “China Merchants Land Limited 招商局置地有限公司” became effective on 1 November 2013.

The certificate of incorporation on change of name was issued by the Registrar of Companies in the Cayman Islands on 1 November 2013. The change of name has also been registered with the Registrar of Companies in Hong Kong. The certificate of registration of change of corporate name of non-Hong Kong company was issued by the Registrar of Companies in Hong Kong under Part XI of the Companies Ordinance (Cap. 32 Laws of Hong Kong) on 21 November 2013.

CHANGE OF STOCK SHORT NAME

The English and Chinese stock short names of the Company for trading in the shares of the Company on the Stock Exchange will be changed from “TONIC IND HOLD” to “CHI MER LAND” in English and “東力實業控股” to “招商局置地” in Chinese, respectively, with effect from 9:00 a.m. on 29 November 2013. The stock code of the Company remains as “978”.

EFFECTS OF THE CHANGE OF COMPANY NAME

The change of company name will not affect any rights of the Shareholders. All existing share certificates in issue bearing the previous name of the Company will continue to be evidence of title to the shares of the Company and will be valid for trading, settlement, registration and delivery purposes. There will not be any arrangement for free exchange of existing share certificates for new share certificates under the new name of the Company. New share certificates will be issued under the new name of the Company.
