SUMMARY OF POWER GENERATION FOR DECEMBER 2020

This voluntary announcement is made by Beijing Enterprises Clean Energy Group Limited (the “**Company**”, together with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”) to keep the shareholders and potential investors of the Company informed of the latest business development of the Group.

The board (the “**Board**”) of directors (the “**Directors**”) of the Company announces that, according to the Company’s preliminary statistics currently available, the power generation of the Group and the joint ventures of the Group was approximately 294,301 megawatt-hour (“**MWh**”) for December 2020, representing an increase of approximately 11.3% as compared to the corresponding period of 2019. For the year ended 31 December 2020, the aggregate power generation of the Group and the joint ventures of the Group amounted to approximately 3,891,207 MWh, representing an increase of approximately 5.5% compared with the corresponding period of 2019.

Among them, details of the power generation of the Group's centralised photovoltaic power plants (including those held by the joint ventures of the Group) and wind power plants are set out as follows:
