CHARACTERISTICS OF GEM

GEM has been positioned as a market designed to accommodate companies to which a higher investment risk may be attached than other companies listed on the Stock Exchange. Prospective investors should be aware of the potential risks of investing in such companies and should make the decision to invest only after due and careful consideration. The greater risk profile and other characteristics of GEM mean that it is a market more suited to professional and other sophisticated investors.

**PROPOSED CHANGE OF COMPANY NAME
AND
NOTICE OF EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL MEETING**

INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this circular is to provide you with information regarding the resolution to be proposed at the EGM to seek Shareholders approval for, among other things, the proposed Change of Company Name.

This circular contains further information relating to the resolution proposed so as to enable you to make an informed decision on whether to vote for or against the resolution proposed. A notice for convening the EGM is also set out in this circular and a form of proxy is also included for your further action.

LETTER FROM THE BOARD

PROPOSED CHANGE OF COMPANY NAME

The Board announced on 2 May 2018 that it proposed to change the English name of the Company from “Prosten Health Holdings Limited” to “China Brilliant Global Limited” and to adopt the Chinese name of “朗華國際集團有限公司” as the dual foreign name of the Company in place of its existing Chinese name “長達健康控股有限公司”, subject to the conditions set out below being fulfilled.

Conditions for the Change of Company Name

The proposed Change of Company Name is conditional upon the following conditions having been satisfied:

- (i) the passing of a special resolution by the Shareholders approving the proposed Change of Company Name at the EGM; and
- (ii) the Registrar of Companies in the Cayman Islands granting approval for the Change of Company Name.

Subject to the satisfaction of the conditions set out above, the Change of Company Name will take effect from the date on which the Registrar of Companies in the Cayman Islands enters the new English name of the Company on the register of companies in place of the former English name and dual foreign name and issues a certificate of incorporation on change of name. The Company will then carry out all necessary filing procedures with the Companies Registry in Hong Kong.

Reasons for the Change of Company Name

In order to enhance the long-term growth potential of the Group, the Company has formulated long-term business strategy to explore other business or investment opportunities and broaden its scope of business. The Board is of the view that a change of company name will help establish a fresh corporate image identity and better reflect the Group’s future business plans and development. As such, the Board considers that the Proposed Change of Company Name is in the best interests of the Company and its Shareholders as a whole.

Effects of the Change of Company Name

The proposed Change of Company Name will not affect any rights of the Shareholders or the Company’s daily operations or its financial position. Once the Change of Company Name has become effective, any new share certificates of the Company issued thereafter will bear the new name of the Company. However, all the existing share certificates in issue bearing the present name of the Company will, after the proposed Change of Company Name having become effective, continue to be effective and as documents of title to the shares of the Company and will continue to be valid for trading, settlement, registration and delivery purposes. Accordingly, there will not be any arrangement for free exchange of the existing

share certificates of the Company for new share certificates bearing the new name of the Company. Under the Cayman Islands Companies Law, the register of members of the Company is by statute regarded as prima facie evidence of title to the shares issued by the Company.

In addition, subject to the confirmation by the Stock Exchange, the English and Chinese stock short names of the Company for trading in the securities on the Stock Exchange will also be changed after the Change of Company Name becoming effective.

EGM

A notice convening the EGM to be held at 29/F., 9 Des Voeux Road West, Hong Kong, on Monday, 28 May 2018 at 3:00 p.m. is set out on pages 6 to 7 of this circular.

Pursuant to Rule 17.47(4) of the GEM Listing Rules, any votes of the Shareholders at the EGM must be taken by poll except where the chairman, in good faith, decides to allow a resolution which relates purely to a procedural or administrative matter to be voted on by a show of hands. The poll results announcement will be announced by the Company after the EGM in the manner prescribed under Rule 17.47(5) of the GEM Listing Rules.

In order to ascertain the entitlements to attend the EGM, the register of members of the Company will be closed from Wednesday, 23 May 2018 to Monday, 28 May 2018 (both dates inclusive) during which period no transfer of Shares will be registered. In order to qualify for exercising the voting rights of shareholders of the Company at the EGM, all transfers accompanied by the relevant share certificate(s), must be lodged with the Company's branch share registrar in Hong Kong, Tricor Tengis Limited at Level 22, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Hong Kong, not later than 4:30 p.m. on Monday, 21 May 2018.

PROXY ARRANGEMENT

A form of proxy for use at the EGM is enclosed with this circular. - (1) At the EGM, the Chairman of the EGM will put the above resolution to be voted by way of a poll pursuant to the Rules (the “**GEM Listing Rules**”) Governing the Listing of Securities on GEM of The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the “**Stock Exchange**”).
- (2) Any member entitled to attend and vote at the EGM is entitled to appoint another person as his proxy to attend and vote in his stead.
