FURTHER DELAY IN DESPATCH OF CIRCULAR

As stated in the Announcements, the Circular containing, among other things, (i) further details of the Subscription Agreements; (ii) further details of the Capital Reorganisation; and (iii) the notice of the SGM, will be despatched to the Shareholders on or before 23 August 2019. Furthermore, as stated in the Winding Up Petition Announcement, the Company is in the course of negotiating with the Petitioner for an amicable disposal of the Petition out of the court before the Hearing Date. As the Subscription and the Capital Reorganisation are also subject to the status of the Petition, the Company requires additional time to finalise certain information in the Circular and deal with the Petition with its legal adviser, it is expected that the despatch date of the Circular will be further postponed to a date falling on or before 20 September 2019.

REVISED EXPECTED TIMETABLE

In view of the further delay in the despatch of the Circular, the expected timetable of the Capital Reorganisation will be revised and disclosed in further announcement(s) and the Circular when and where appropriate.
