China Power Announced Gross Generation and Total Net Generation for the First Quarter of 2008

China Power International Development Limited (the “Company”, stock code: 2380) announced today its gross generation and total net generation for the first quarter ended 31 March 2008.

According to its preliminary statistics, the consolidated gross generation of the power plants of the Company (excluding the power plant of its associated company) amounted to 8,536,675 MWh for the first quarter ended 31 March 2008, representing a year-on-year increase of 50.66 % while its consolidated net generation totalled to 7,973,663 MWh, representing a year-on-year increase of 52.00 %.

The increase in the gross generation for the first quarter of 2008 was mainly attributable to (1) the commence of operation of unit No.3, 4 of Pingwei Power Plant II and No. 5,6 of Yaomeng Power Plant II. (2)the Company took advantages of mine mouth power plant, overcome impacts of storms and strengthened production management.

The respective gross generation figures of the power plants of the Company and its associated company for the first quarter ended 31 March 2008 are as follows:

The shares of the Company have been listed on the Main Board of The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited since 15 October 2004. The Company is the flagship company of China Power Investment Corporation (one of the five national power generation groups in China) and its principal business is to develop, construct, manage and operate power plants in China. The Company has 100% ownership in its five large-capacity coal-fired power plants under commercial operation and 50% equity interest in the associated company, Changshu Power Plant. The Company owned as controlling shareholder one large-capacity coal-fired power plants which is under construction. Meanwhile, the Company also owns a 21.92% stake in Shanghai Electric Power Co., Ltd, which is listed on the Shanghai Stock Exchange. Currently, China Power has an attributable installed capacity of approximately 7,883 MW.
