China Power Announced its Gross Generation and Total Net Generation for the First 3 Quarters of 2008

China Power International Development Limited (the “Company”, Stock Code: 2380) today announced its gross generation and total net generation for the first 3 quarters of the year ended 30 September 2008, also revealed the second 640MW supercritical coal-fired generating unit of Dabieshan Power Plant passed the 168-hour full load trial run and commenced commercial operation on September 27, 2008.

According to its preliminary statistics, the consolidated gross generation and total net generation of the power plants of the Company (excluding the power plant of its associated company) amounted to 26,345,898 MWh for the first 3 quarters of the year ended 30 September 2008, representing a year-on-year increase of 35.95% while its consolidated net generation totalled to 24,519,027 MWh, representing a year-on-year increase of 36.38%.

The increase in the gross generation for the first 3 quarters of 2008 was mainly attributable to (1) the commence of operation of unit No.3, 4 of Pingwei Power Plant, unit No. 5,6 of Yaomeng Power Plant II and unit No.1 of Dabieshan power plant. (2) improved reliability over operation for units of each power plant due to the strengthened management of the production.

The respective total net generation figures of the power plants of the Company and its associated company for the first 3 quarters of the year ended 30 September 2008 are as follows:

CHINA POWER INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT LIMITED

The shares of the Company have been listed on the Main Board of The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited since 15 October 2004. The Company is the flagship company of China Power Investment Corporation (one of the five national power generation groups in China) and its principal business is to develop, construct, manage and operate power plants in China. The Company has 100% or controlling interest in its six large-capacity coal-fired power plants under commercial operation and 50% equity interest in the associated company, Changshu Power Plant. Meanwhile, the Company also owns a 21.92% stake in Shanghai Electric Power Co., Ltd, which is listed on the Shanghai Stock Exchange. Currently, China Power has an attributable installed capacity of approximately 9,432.4 MW.

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
