China Power Announced its Gross Generation and Total Net Generation in 2008

China Power International Development Limited (the “Company” and stock code: 2380) announces today its gross generation and net generation for the year ended 31 December 2008.

According to the Company’s preliminary statistics, the consolidated gross generation of the power plants of the Company (excluding the power plant of its associated company) for the year ended 31 December 2008 amounted to 36,360,449 MWh, representing an increase of 36.17% compared with last year. The consolidated total net generation was 33,889,570 MWh, representing an increase of 36.59% compared with the same period of last year.

The increase in the gross generation of the Company for 2008 was mainly attributable to (1) the commence of operation of unit No.3, 4 of Pingwei Power Plant II, unit No. 5,6 of Yaomeng Power Plant II and unit No.1, 2 of Dabieshan power plant. (2)improved reliability over operation for units of each power plant due to the strengthened management of the production.

CHINA POWER INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT LIMITED

The shares of the Company have been listed on the Main Board of The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited since 15 October 2004. The Company is the flagship company of China Power Investment Corporation (one of the five national power generation groups in China) and its principal business is to develop, construct, manage and operate power plants in China. The Company has 100% or controlling interest in its six large-capacity coal-fired power plants under commercial operation and 50% equity interest in the associated company, Changshu Power Plant. Meanwhile, the Company also owns a 21.92% stake in Shanghai Electric Power Co., Ltd, which is listed on the Shanghai Stock Exchange. Currently, China Power has an attributable installed capacity of approximately 9,432.4 MW.

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
