Poll Results of Annual General Meeting and Payment of the Final Dividend

The Board of Directors (the “Board”) of China Unicom (Hong Kong) Limited (the “Company”) is pleased to announce that the Annual General Meeting of the Company (the “AGM”) was held on Tuesday, 26 May 2026. The number of issued shares of the Company as at the date of the AGM was 30,598,124,345, which was the total number of shares entitling the holders to attend and vote for or against any of the resolutions proposed at the AGM. There were no restrictions on any shareholders casting votes on any of the proposed resolutions at the AGM. Besides, there were no shares entitling the holders to attend and abstain from voting in favour of the resolutions at the AGM as set out in the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the “Listing Rules”) and there were no shares requiring the holders to abstain from voting at the AGM under the Listing Rules. Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, the Company’s share registrar, acted as scrutineer for the vote-taking at the AGM. Mr. Tang Yongbo, Mrs. Law Fan Chiu Fun Fanny and Mr. Fan Chun Wah Andrew attended the AGM in person. Mr. Cheung Wing Lam Linus attended the AGM by electronic means. The other directors were unable to attend the AGM, due to other business commitment.

Payment of the Final Dividend

The final dividend of RMB0.1329 per share (equivalent to HK\$0.15229 per share) (pre-tax) for the year ended 31 December 2025 was approved at the AGM. The relevant exchange rate was the mid-rate of Renminbi to Hong Kong dollars as announced by the People's Bank of China on 21 May 2026, being the second business day prior to the date of declaration of dividends at the AGM (RMB0.87267 equivalent to HK\$1.00). The dividend will be paid to shareholders whose names appear on the register of members of the Company on Friday, 5 June 2026. The register of members will be closed on Friday, 5 June 2026. In order to be entitled to the final dividend, shareholders who have not registered the transfer documents are required to deposit the transfer documents together with the relevant share certificates at Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, at Shops 1712 - 1716, 17th Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong at or before 4:30 p.m. on Thursday, 4 June 2026. The final dividend is expected to be paid on or around 24 June 2026.
