NOTICE OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Annual General Meeting of Convenience Retail Asia Limited (the "Company") will be held at 1/F, LiFung Tower, 888 Cheung Sha Wan Road, Kowloon, Hong Kong on Wednesday, 24 May 2023 at 4:00 p.m. (or, in the event that a black rainstorm warning signal or tropical cyclone warning signal no. 8 or above or post-super typhoon extreme conditions is in force in Hong Kong at 1:00 p.m. on that day, at the same place on Thursday, 25 May 2023 at 4:00 p.m.) for the following purposes:

ORDINARY RESOLUTIONS

- To receive and adopt the Audited Consolidated Financial Statements and the Reports of the Directors and the Auditor of the Company and its subsidiaries for the year ended 31 December 2022.
- 2. To declare a final dividend for the year ended 31 December 2022.
- 3. To re-elect the following Directors:
 - (a) Dr William Fung Kwok Lun;
 - (b) Dr Sarah Mary Liao Sau Tung; and
 - (c) Mr Terrence Tsang Diao-Long.
- 4. To re-appoint PricewaterhouseCoopers as Auditor and authorise the Board to fix their remuneration.

As special business, to consider and, if thought fit, pass the following resolutions as ordinary resolutions:

5. **"THAT**:

- (a) subject to paragraph (c) of this Resolution, the exercise by the Directors of the Company during the Relevant Period (as hereinafter defined) of all the powers of the Company to allot, issue and deal with additional shares in the share capital of the Company (the "Shares") and to make or grant offers, agreements and options which might require the exercise of such powers be and is hereby generally and unconditionally approved;
- (b) the approval in paragraph (a) of this Resolution shall authorise the Directors of the Company during the Relevant Period to make or grant offers, agreements and options which might require the exercise of such powers after the end of the Relevant Period;
- the number of Shares allotted, issued or dealt with or agreed conditionally or (c) unconditionally to be allotted, issued or dealt with (whether pursuant to an option or otherwise) by the Directors of the Company pursuant to the approval in paragraph (a) of this Resolution, otherwise than pursuant to (i) a Rights Issue (as hereinafter defined); or (ii) the exercise of options under any share option schemes adopted by the Company or similar arrangement for the time being adopted by the Company; or (iii) any scrip dividend or similar arrangement providing for the allotment of Shares in lieu of the whole or part of a dividend on Shares in accordance with the Articles of Association of the Company in force from time to time; or (iv) the exercise of rights of subscription or conversion under the terms of any existing warrants of the Company or any existing securities of the Company which are convertible into Shares, shall not exceed 10% of the number of issued Shares on the date of the passing of this Resolution, and the authority pursuant to paragraph (a) of this Resolution shall be limited accordingly; and
- (d) for the purpose of this Resolution,

"Relevant Period" means the period from the passing of this Resolution until whichever is the earliest of:

- (i) the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company;
- (ii) the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required by the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company, or any applicable laws of the Cayman Islands, to be held; and
- (iii) the date on which the authority set out in this Resolution is revoked or varied by an ordinary resolution of the shareholders of the Company in general meeting.

"Rights Issue" means an offer of Shares, warrants, options or other securities which are attached with rights to subscribe for Shares, open for a period fixed by the Directors of the Company to holders of Shares whose names appear on the register of members of the Company on a fixed record date in proportion to their then holdings of such Shares (subject to such exclusion or other arrangements as the Directors of the Company may deem necessary or expedient in relation to fractional entitlements, or having regard to any restrictions or obligations under the laws of, or the requirements of, any recognised regulatory body or any stock exchange in, any territory applicable to the Company)."

6. **"THAT**:

- (a) subject to paragraph (b) of this Resolution, the exercise by the Directors of the Company during the Relevant Period (as hereinafter defined) of all the powers of the Company to repurchase Shares on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the "Stock Exchange") or any other stock exchange on which the Shares may be listed and recognised by the Securities and Futures Commission of Hong Kong and the Stock Exchange for such purpose, subject to and in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Securities and Futures Commission, the Stock Exchange and any such other stock exchange from time to time and all applicable laws in this regard, be and is hereby generally and unconditionally approved;
- (b) the number of Shares which the Directors of the Company are authorised to repurchase pursuant to the approval in paragraph (a) of this Resolution shall not exceed 10% of the number of issued Shares on the date of the passing of this Resolution, and the said approval shall be limited accordingly; and
- (c) for the purpose of this Resolution,

"Relevant Period" means the period from the passing of this Resolution until whichever is the earliest of:

- (i) the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company;
- (ii) the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required by the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company, or any applicable laws of the Cayman Islands, to be held; and
- (iii) the date on which the authority set out in this Resolution is revoked or varied by an ordinary resolution of the shareholders of the Company in general meeting."

SPECIAL RESOLUTION

7. To consider as special business, and, if thought fit, pass the following resolution as a special resolution:

"THAT the proposed amendments (the "Proposed Amendments") to the existing memorandum of association and articles of association of the Company as set out in Appendix III to the circular of the Company dated 18 April 2023 (the "Circular") and the amended and restated memorandum of association and articles of association of the Company (the "New Memorandum and Articles of Association") (a copy of which has been produced to this meeting and marked "A" and initialed by the chairman of this meeting for the purpose of identification) which consolidates all the Proposed Amendments mentioned in the Circular, be and are hereby approved with immediate effect after the close of this meeting, and any one Director or the company secretary of the Company be and are hereby authorised to do all such acts, deeds, and things and execute all documents he or she may, in his or her absolute discretion, deem fit, to effect and implement the adoption of the New Memorandum and Articles of Association thereof."
