INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this circular is to provide you with information regarding the proposals for the Issue Mandate, the Repurchase Mandate, the re-election of the retiring Directors and to seek your approval at the AGM in connection with, among others things, such matters.

LETTER FROM THE BOARD

THE ISSUE MANDATE

On 18 May 2012, the Shareholders passed an ordinary resolution to give a general mandate to the Directors to allot, issue and deal with Shares. Such general mandate will lapse at the conclusion of the AGM. It is therefore proposed to renew such general mandate at the AGM.

Ordinary resolutions will be proposed at the AGM to grant to the Directors the Issue Mandate and authorize the extension of the Issue Mandate, details of which are set out in item nos. 5 and 7 respectively in the notice of AGM.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the issued ordinary share capital of the Company comprised 1,386,631,522 Shares. Subject to the passing of the resolution approving the Issue Mandate and on the basis that no further Shares are issued prior to the AGM, the Company would be allowed under the resolution approving the Issue Mandate to issue a maximum of 277,326,304 Shares representing not more than 20% of the issued ordinary share capital of the Company as at the date of passing of the resolution approving the Issue Mandate.

THE REPURCHASE MANDATE

Also on 18 May 2012, the Shareholders passed an ordinary resolution to give a general mandate to the Directors to exercise the powers of the Company to repurchase its own Shares. Such general mandate will lapse at the conclusion of the AGM. It is therefore proposed to renew such general mandate at the AGM.

An ordinary resolution will be proposed at the AGM to grant to the Directors the Repurchase Mandate, details of which are set out in item no. 6 in the notice of AGM.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the issued ordinary share capital of the Company comprised 1,386,631,522 Shares. Subject to the passing of the resolution approving the Repurchase Mandate and on the basis that no further Shares are issued prior to the AGM, the Company would be allowed under the resolution approving the Repurchase Mandate to repurchase a maximum of 138,663,152 Shares representing not more than 10% of the issued ordinary share capital of the Company as at the date of passing of the resolution approving the Repurchase Mandate.

An explanatory statement as required under the Listing Rules, giving certain information regarding the Repurchase Mandate, is set out in Appendix I to this circular.

LETTER FROM THE BOARD

RE-ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The Board currently consists of nine Directors, namely Mr. Zhao Qingsheng (*Chairman*), Mr. Gao Xiang (*General Manager*), Mr. Jin Jianlong and Mr. Yu Yuqun as executive Directors; Mr. Jin Yongsheng and Mr. Petrus Gerardus Maria van der Burg as non-executive Directors; and Mr. Wong Chun Ho, Mr. Tsui Kei Pang and Mr. Zhang Xueqian as independent non-executive Directors.

In accordance with articles 87(1) and 87(2) of the Articles, Messrs. Petrus Gerardus Maria van der Burg, Tsui Kei Pang and Zhang Xueqian will retire by rotation at the AGM and, being eligible, offer themselves for re-election.

Brief biographical details of the Directors proposed to be re-elected at the AGM are set out in Appendix II to this circular.

PROPOSED FINAL DIVIDEND

On 19 March 2013, the Board recommended that subject to Shareholders' approval in the AGM, the Company shall declare and distribute a final dividend in respect of 2012 of HKD0.07 per ordinary share and HKD0.07 per non-redeemable convertible preference share to its shareholders whose names appear on the register of members of the Company on 27 May 2013.

The Board further resolved that the register of members of the Company shall be closed from Friday, 24 May 2013 to Monday, 27 May 2013 (both days inclusive), during which period no share transfer will be registered for the purpose of ascertaining shareholders' entitlements to the proposed final dividend.

In order to qualify for the proposed final dividend, all share transfers accompanied by the relevant share certificates must be lodged with the Company's branch share registrar in Hong Kong, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, at Rooms 1712-1716, 17th Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong, not later than 4:30 p.m. on Thursday, 23 May 2013.

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The notice convening the AGM to consider, amongst other things, ordinary resolutions relating to the Issue Mandate, the Repurchase Mandate and the extension of the Issue Mandate and the re-election of retiring Directors are set out in pages 13 to 17 of this circular.

VOTING BY WAY OF POLL

Pursuant to Rule 13.39(4) of the Listing Rules, all votes of Shareholders at the AGM will be taken by poll except where the chairman of the meeting, in good faith, decides to allow a resolution which relates purely to a procedural or administrative matter to be voted on by a show of hands. The Company will announce the results of the poll in the manner prescribed under Rule 13.39(5) of the Listing Rules.

LETTER FROM THE BOARD

ACTION TO BE TAKEN

A proxy form for use at the AGM is enclosed herein. Whether or not you propose to attend the AGM, you are requested to complete the proxy form in accordance with the instructions printed thereon and return the same to the Company's branch share registrar in Hong Kong, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, at 17M Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong as soon as possible and in any event not less than 48 hours before the time appointed for the holding of the meeting or any adjournment thereof. Completion and return of the proxy form will not preclude Shareholders from attending and voting in person at the AGM, or any adjourned meeting, should they so wish.

RECOMMENDATION

The Directors are of the opinion that the proposed resolutions referred in this circular and the notice of AGM are in the best interests of the Company and the Shareholders as a whole. Accordingly, the Directors recommend the Shareholders to vote in favour of all the resolutions as set out in the notice of AGM.

This appendix serves as an explanatory statement, as required by the Listing Rules, to provide you with requisite information for your consideration of the Repurchase Mandate.

1. EXERCISE OF THE REPURCHASE MANDATE

Exercise in full of the Repurchase Mandate, on the basis of 1,386,631,522 Shares in issue at the Latest Practicable Date, could result in up to 138,663,152 Shares being repurchased by the Company during the period up to (i) the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company; (ii) the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required by the Articles or any applicable laws to be held; or (iii) the revocation, variation or renewal of the Repurchase Mandate by ordinary resolution of the Shareholders in general meeting, whichever occurs first.

2. REASONS FOR REPURCHASES

Repurchases of Shares will only be made when the Directors believe that such a repurchase will benefit the Company and the Shareholders. Such repurchases may, depending on market conditions and funding arrangements at the time, lead to an enhancement of the net asset value of the Company and/or its earnings per Share.

3. FUNDING OF REPURCHASES

In repurchasing Shares, the Company may only apply funds legally available for such purpose in accordance with its memorandum and articles of association and the applicable laws of the Cayman Islands. The law of the Cayman Islands provides that the amount to be repaid in connection with a share repurchase may be paid from the profits of the Company and/or the proceeds of a new issue of Shares made for the purpose of the repurchase or out of capital, if the Company can, immediately following such payment, pay its debts as they fall due in the ordinary course of business. The Company may not purchase securities on the Stock Exchange for a consideration other than cash or for settlement otherwise than in accordance with the trading rules of the Stock Exchange from time to time.

4. GENERAL

There might be a material adverse impact on the working capital or gearing position of the Company (as compared with the position disclosed in the audited financial statements contained in the Annual Report 2012 of the Company) in the event that the Repurchase Mandate is exercised in full. However, the Directors do not propose to exercise the Repurchase Mandate to such extent as would, in the circumstances, have a material adverse effect on the working capital requirements of the Company or on its gearing position which in the opinion of the Directors are from time to time appropriate for the Company.

The Directors have undertaken to the Stock Exchange that, so far as the same may be applicable, they will exercise the Repurchase Mandate in accordance with the Listing Rules, the memorandum and articles of association of the Company and the applicable laws of the Cayman Islands.

None of the Directors and, to the best of their knowledge, having made all reasonable enquiries, none of their respective associates (as defined in the Listing Rules), have any present intention, in the event that the Repurchase Mandate is approved by Shareholders, to sell Shares to the Company.

No connected person (as defined in the Listing Rules) of the Company has notified the Company that he has a present intention to sell Shares to the Company or has undertaken not to do so, in the event that the Company is authorised to make purchase of Shares.

If as a result of a repurchase of Shares, a Shareholder's proportionate interest in the voting rights of the Company increases, such increase will be treated as an acquisition for the purpose of the Takeovers Code. As a result, a Shareholder, or a group of Shareholders acting in concert, depending on the level of increase in the Shareholder's interests, could obtain or consolidate control of the Company and become(s) obliged to make a mandatory offer in accordance with Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, CIMC was beneficially, interested in an aggregate of 827,335,645 Shares, representing approximately 59.67% of the issued ordinary share capital of the Company. Based on such shareholdings and in the event that the Directors exercised in full the power to repurchase Shares under the Repurchase Mandate, the aggregate shareholdings of CIMC would be increased to approximately 66.29% of the issued ordinary share capital of the Company. The Directors are not aware of any consequence which may arise under the Takeovers Code as a consequence of any repurchases made under the Repurchase Mandate. The Company may not repurchase Shares which would result in the amount of Shares held by the public being reduced to less than 25%.

5. SHARE PURCHASED BY THE COMPANY

The Company has not purchased any of its Shares (whether on the Stock Exchange or otherwise) in the six months preceding the Latest Practicable Date.

The following are the particulars of the Directors proposed to be re-elected at the AGM:

Mr. Petrus Gerardus Maria van der Burg

Mr. van der Burg, aged 59, joined the Group as a non-executive Director in September 2009. He graduated from the Rotterdam Technical Institutions, majoring in steel structures. Mr. van der Burg acted as a mechanical engineer in van Veen en Ettinger Rotterdam, the Netherlands in 1978. From 1978 to 2007, he held various chief executive positions and directorships in Burg Industries B.V., the former holding company of certain subsidiaries of the Company. Mr. van der Burg has many years of management experience in the tank container industry. Under his leadership, a well-known South African tank container producer developed various types of standard and special stainless steel tank containers. Mr. van der Burg holds directorship in certain subsidiaries of the Company and CIMC respectively.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, Mr. van der Burg owned 99.50% interests and his spouse owned the remaining 0.50% of P.G.M. Holding B.V., a substantial shareholder of the Company. He was also interested in an aggregate of 918,000 share options which were outstanding. The options were granted by the Company on 11 November 2009 and 28 October 2011 under the Share Option Scheme.

Mr. van der Burg has renewed his appointment letter with the Company with a term of three years commencing on 30 September 2012, subject to certain early termination clauses of the letter. The appointment is subject to retirement by rotation and re-election at the annual general meeting of the Company according to the Articles. Pursuant to the appointment letter, Mr. van der Burg is entitled to no director's remuneration.

Save as disclosed above, Mr. van der Burg (i) has not held any other positions with any members of the Group; (ii) is not related to any director, senior management, substantial shareholder or controlling shareholder of the Company or other members of the Group; (iii) is not interested in the shares of the Company within the meaning of Part XV of the SFO; and (iv) has not held any other directorships in any listed public companies in the last three years.

Save as disclosed above, Mr. van der Burg has confirmed that there are no other matters that need to be brought to the attention of the Shareholders in connection with his re-election and there is no other information that should be disclosed pursuant to any of the requirements of Rule 13.51(2) of the Listing Rules.

Mr. Tsui Kei Pang

Mr. Tsui, aged 52, joined the Group as an independent non-executive Director since November 2009. He is also the chairman of the remuneration committee and a member of the audit committee of the Company. He obtained a bachelor's degree in law (Honours) and a master's degree in law from The University of Hong Kong. He is a solicitor of Hong Kong, a solicitor of England and Wales (non-practising), a China Appointed Attesting Officer and a Civil Celebrant of Marriages. Mr. Tsui is currently a partner of Gallant Y.T. Ho & Co. and specialises in China business practices. He is also the vice chairman of the Greater China Legal Affairs Committee of The Law Society of Hong Kong, an honorary legal adviser of The Hong Kong Real Estate Association as well as a member of China Committee of Hong Kong General Chamber of Commerce.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, Mr. Tsui was interested in an aggregate of 300,000 share options which were outstanding. The options were granted by the Company on 28 October 2011 under the Share Option Scheme.

Mr. Tsui has renewed his appointment letter with the Company with a term of three years commencing on 11 November 2012, subject to certain early termination clauses of the letter. The appointment is subject to retirement by rotation and re-election at the annual general meeting of the Company according to the Articles. Pursuant to the appointment letter, Mr. Tsui is entitled to receive a director's fee of HKD180,000 per annum.

Mr. Zhang Xueqian

Mr. Zhang, aged 63, joined the Group as an independent non-executive Director since September 2010. He received a PhD degree in accounting from Xi'an Jiaotong University (西安交通大學) and a master's degree in economics from Wuhan University (武漢大學). He is a registered accountant in the PRC. Presently, Mr. Zhang is a professor of the Business School of University of International Business and Economics (對外經濟貿易大學國際商學院) in the PRC, and was a former associate dean of the school. He was also a senior member of the Chinese Society of Technology and Economics (中國技術經濟研究會) and a researcher of Beijing Asia-Pacific Research Center of China Financial Accounting (北京亞太華夏財務會計研究中心). Mr. Zhang possesses strong academic background in accounting and finance.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, Mr. Zhang was interested in an aggregate of 300,000 share options which were outstanding. The options were granted by the Company on 28 October 2011 under the Share Option Scheme.

Mr. Zhang has entered into an appointment letter with the Company with an initial term of three years commencing on 30 September 2010, subject to certain early termination clauses of the letter. The appointment is subject to retirement by rotation and re-election at the annual general meeting of the Company according to the Articles. Pursuant to the appointment letter, Mr. Zhang is entitled to receive a director's fee of HKD180,000 per annum.
