EuroEyes Continues to Pioneer in Ophthalmology, Becoming First in Market to Use the Latest Vision Correction Laser Systems From Schwind and ZEISS

Hong Kong, 31 October 2022 – EuroEyes International Eye Clinic Limited ("EuroEyes" or the "Company", together with its subsidiaries, the "Group", HKEX: 1846), a leading global vision correction service provider, became first eye clinic group worldwide to adopt the latest and most advanced vision correction laser systems from renowned equipment manufacturers Schwind and ZEISS.

Recently, Dr. med. Ralf-Christian Lerche, Executive Director of EuroEyes, performed the first SmartSight laser treatment in Germany using the first commercially available SCHWIND ATOS® femtosecond laser, and the EuroEyes clinic in Copenhagen was the first eye clinic globally to use the first commercially available ZEISS VISUMAX® 800 femtosecond laser, the latest device for ReLEx SMILE.

With a commitment to helping clients worldwide regain clear vision, EuroEyes continually upgrades its equipment to help its surgeons perform the most precise, safe, and least invasive operations on their patients.

Dr. med. Jørn S. Jørgensen, Founder, Chairman and CEO of EuroEyes, said: "We are seeing a growing number of people globally seeking treatment for myopia, presbyopia, and other eye vision issues. For some of them, the thought of eye surgery may be unsettling. Therefore, as a world-leader in ophthalmology, EuroEyes continuously innovates and invests in the latest technology and equipment that enables us to perform eye treatments more effectively, reduce surgery time, and in turn give our patients the most comfortable experience."

A Technical Pioneer in Laser Vision Correction

In August 2022, Dr. Lerche, who is also Senior Vice President, Medical Affairs (Germany) at EuroEyes, was the first doctor to use the first commercially available SCHWIND ATOS for SmartSight laser treatments in Germany, an alternative to ReLEx SMILE.

The SCHWIND ATOS femtosecond laser, which had been tested for a year, sets a new benchmark in safety and precision in laser vision correction. Its advanced eye tracking system, featuring pupil recognition and cyclotorsion compensation, enables precise centering of the patient's eye along the visual axis, which can be particularly helpful in the correction of astigmatism. The system's curved patient interface geometry reduces pressure on the eye and patient discomfort during the contacting process. With a pulse rate of up to 4 megahertz, sophisticated pulse characteristics, and refined positioning algorithms, the SCHWIND ATOS shortens treatment and incision time, giving patients a more comfortable experience and allowing doctors to perform surgeries more efficiently.

Also in August 2022, the EuroEyes Copenhagen clinic was the first eye clinic worldwide to use the first commercially available new ZEISS VISUMAX® 800 femtosecond laser for vision correction treatment.

The ZEISS VISUMAX® 800 can create the lenticule in less than 10 seconds and complete a flap cut in approximately 5 seconds due to a fast laser pulse repetition rate of 500 Hz. With fast cutting speed and short suction time, this reduces the stress on patients during laser treatment. Its smart robotic assistant systems, such as cyclotorsion and centration aid, can enhance the surgeon's control during procedures. The ZEISS VISUMAX® 800 was designed to deliver state-of-the-art performance, making the surgical experience comfortable and reassuring for both doctors and patients.

Dr. Jørgensen added: "We are pleased to introduce the Schwind and ZEISS systems into our clinics, and provide our clients the most comfortable vision correction experience with the most advanced technologies available. EuroEyes has always been a pioneer in ophthalmology, collaborating with our partners and world-leading academics to discover new techniques that can improve the quality of our treatments.
