NOTICE OF EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL MEETING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an extraordinary general meeting (the “**EGM**”) of Hong Kong Entertainment International Holdings Limited (the “**Company**”) will be held at Portion 2, 12/F, The Center, 99 Queen’s Road Central, Central, Hong Kong on Wednesday, 2 September 2026 at 11:00 a.m., or at any adjournment thereof, for the purpose of considering and, if thought fit, passing (with or without amendment) the following resolutions which will be proposed as ordinary resolutions:

ORDINARY RESOLUTIONS

1. “**THAT** subject to the conditions set out in the letter from the board under the heading “Conditions of the Rights Issue” in the circular of the Company dated 12 August 2026:
 - (a) the allotment and issue of 159,999,999 new Shares (assuming no change in the number of Shares in issue on or before the Record Date (as defined below) and that no new Shares (other than the Rights Shares) will be allotted and issued on or before completion of the Rights Issue) (the “**Rights Shares**”) pursuant to an offer by way of rights issue to the shareholders of the Company (the “**Shareholder(s)**”) at the subscription price of HK\$0.20 per Rights Share (the “**Subscription Price**”) on the basis of three (3) Rights Shares for every one (1) Share held by the Shareholders (“**Qualifying Shareholder(s)**”) whose names appear on the register of members of the Company on Monday, 14 September 2026, or such other date as may be determined by the Company for determining entitlements of Shareholders to participate in the Rights Issue (as defined below) (the “**Record Date**”), as described in further details in a circular issued by the Company dated 12 August 2026 (a copy of which has been produced to the EGM marked “A” and signed by the chairman of the EGM for the purpose of identification), save for the Shareholders whose addresses as of the Record Date are outside of Hong Kong (if any) to whom the Directors, based on legal opinions provided by the legal advisers to the Company, consider it necessary or expedient not to offer the Rights Shares on account either of the legal restrictions under the laws of the relevant place(s) of their registered address(es) or the requirements of the relevant regulatory body(ies) or stock exchange(s) in such place(s) (“**Excluded Shareholder(s)**”), and on and subject to such terms and conditions as may be determined by the Directors (the “**Rights Issue**”), be and is hereby approved, confirmed and ratified;

- (b) the placing agreement dated 9 July 2026 (as supplemented by the supplemental placing agreement dated 5 August 2026) (the “**Placing Agreement**”) entered into between the Company and Suncorp Securities Limited (a copy of which has been produced to the EGM marked “B” and signed by the chairman of the EGM for the purpose of identification), in relation to the placing of the Rights Shares not subscribed by the Qualifying Shareholders and/or the Rights Share(s) which would otherwise have been provisionally allotted to the Excluded Shareholder(s) in nil-paid form that has/have not been sold by the Company at the placing price of not less than the Subscription Price on a best effort basis, and the transactions contemplated thereunder be and is hereby approved, confirmed and ratified;
- (c) the board of Directors or a committee thereof be and is hereby authorised to allot and issue the Rights Shares pursuant to or in connection with the Rights Issue notwithstanding that the same may be offered, allotted or issued otherwise than pro rata to the existing Shareholders, and, in particular, the Directors may make such exclusions or other arrangements in relation to any Excluded Shareholders, and to do all such acts and things or make such arrangements as it considers necessary, desirable or expedient to give effect to any or all other transactions contemplated in this resolution; and
- (d) any one or more Directors be and is/are hereby authorised to do all such acts, deeds and things, to sign and execute all such further documents or deeds and to take such steps as he/they may in his/their absolute discretion consider necessary, appropriate, desirable or expedient to carry out or to give effect to or in connection with the Rights Issue, the Placing Agreement and the transactions contemplated thereunder.”

Notes:

- (1) An eligible shareholder is entitled to appoint one or more proxies to attend, speak and vote in his/her stead at the EGM (or at any adjournment of it) provided that each proxy is appointed to represent the respective number of shares held by the shareholder as specified in the relevant proxy forms. The proxy does not need to be a shareholder of the Company.

- (2) Where there are joint registered holders of any shares, any one of such persons may vote at the EGM (or at any adjournment of it), either personally or by proxy, in respect of such shares as if he/she were solely entitled thereto but the vote of the senior holder who tenders a vote, whether in person or by proxy, will be accepted to the exclusion of the vote(s) of the other joint holders and, for this purpose, seniority shall be determined by the order in which the names stand in the register of members of the Company in respect of the relevant joint holding.
- (3) A proxy form for use at the EGM is enclosed.
- (4) In order to be valid, the completed proxy form must be received by the Hong Kong branch share registrar and transfer office of the Company, Tricor Investor Services Limited, at 17/F, Far East Finance Centre, 16 Harcourt Road, Hong Kong, at least 48 hours before the time appointed for holding the EGM (i.e. 11:00 a.m. on Monday, 31 August 2026) or adjourned meeting (as the case may be). If a proxy form is signed by an attorney of a shareholder who is not a corporation, the power of attorney or other authority under which it is signed or a certified copy of that power of attorney or authority (such certification to be made by either a notary public or a solicitor qualified to practice in Hong Kong) must be delivered to the Hong Kong branch share registrar and transfer office of the Company together with the proxy form. In the case of a corporation, the proxy form must either be executed under its common seal or be signed by an officer or agent duly authorised in writing.
- (5) For the purposes of determining shareholders' eligibility to attend, speak and vote at the EGM (or at any adjournment of it), the register of members of the Company will be closed from Thursday, 27 August 2026 to Wednesday, 2 September 2026 (both dates inclusive), during which period no transfer of shares of the Company will be registered. To be eligible to attend, speak and vote at the above meeting (or at any adjournment of it), all properly completed transfer documents accompanied by the relevant share certificate must be lodged with the Hong Kong branch share registrar and transfer office of the Company, Tricor Investor Services Limited, at 17/F, Far East Finance Centre, 16 Harcourt Road, Hong Kong for registration not later than 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, 26 August 2026.
- (6) Detailed information on other business to be transacted at the EGM is set out in this circular.
- (7) As set out in the Letter from the Board included in this circular, each of the resolutions set out in this notice should be voted on by poll.
- (8) The Chinese translation of this notice is for reference only, and in case of any inconsistency, the English version shall prevail.
- (9) If a typhoon signal No. 8 or above is hoisted or a "black" rainstorm warning signal and/or "extreme conditions" is/are in force at or at any time after 7:00 a.m. on the date of the EGM, the EGM will be adjourned. The Company will post an announcement on the website of the Company (<https://www.irasia.com/listco/hk/hkentertainment/>) and the website of The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the "**Stock Exchange**") (www.hkexnews.hk) to notify shareholders of the date, time and place of the adjourned meeting. The EGM will be held as scheduled when an Amber or a Red Rainstorm Warning Signal is in force. Shareholders should decide on their own whether they would attend the EGM under bad weather conditions bearing in mind their own situations.
