HGC was among the world's first telecoms operators to offer ODVLL, its cloud-computing services extend secure connectivity into customer premises.

The ACP Solution comprises a full set of services including data centre facilities, hosting and colocation, seamless integration of local and international networks, IP transit, equipment leasing and management, as well as local remote hands outsourcing. This solution facilitates content exchange, enhances application performance and improves the user experience in a cost-effective manner. Ultimately, the ACP Solution helps over-the-top (OTT) players extend their business coverage around the world.

Andrew Kwok, HGC President of International and Carrier Business, said: "We are delighted that our two projects have won recognition for excellence in business service innovation. It is evident that our continued efforts to offer new services - in the context of our thorough understanding of the international telecoms market - has been key to winning these accolades.
