ORDINARY RESOLUTIONS

1. To receive and consider the audited financial statements and the reports of the directors and the independent auditor of the Company for the year ended 30 June 2025.
2. To declare a final dividend for the year ended 30 June 2025.
3. (a) To re-elect Mr. Nicholas James Debnam as an independent non-executive director of the Company.

(b) To re-elect Mr. Yuan Ren as an independent non-executive director of the Company.

(c) To authorise the board of directors of the Company (the “Board”) to fix the remuneration of the directors.
4. To elect Mr. Lung Chi Sing Alex as an executive director of the Company and to authorise the Board to fix his remuneration.
5. To re-appoint KPMG as auditor of the Company and to authorise the Board to fix its remuneration.

1. A shareholder of the Company entitled to attend and vote at the Annual General Meeting convened by the above notice is entitled to appoint a proxy to attend and vote on his/her behalf. A proxy need not be a shareholder of the Company.
2. The proxy form for use at the Annual General Meeting is enclosed in the circular. Completion and return of the form of proxy will not preclude a member from attending and voting at the Annual General Meeting or any adjournment thereof if he/she so wishes. In that event, his/her form of proxy will be deemed to have been revoked.
3. Where there are joint registered holders of any shares, any one of such persons may vote at the meeting, either personally or by proxy, in respect of such shares as if he/she was solely entitled thereto; but if more than one of such joint holders be present at the meeting personally or by proxy, then one of the said persons whose name stands first on the register of members of the Company in respect of such shares shall alone be entitled to vote in respect thereof.

In order to be valid, a proxy form and the power of attorney or other authority (if any) under which it is signed, or a notarially certified copy of such power of attorney, must be deposited at the Company's branch share registrar in Hong Kong, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, at Shops 1712-1716, 17th Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Wan Chai, Hong Kong not less than 48 hours before the time fixed for holding the Annual General Meeting or any adjourned meeting thereof.

During such period no transfer of shares will be effected. To establish the right to attend and vote at the Annual General Meeting, all transfer documents accompanied by the relevant share certificates must be deposited at the Company's branch share registrar in Hong Kong, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, at Shops 1712-1716, 17th Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Wan Chai, Hong Kong, no later than 4:30 p.m. on Monday, 1 December 2025.

The transfer books and the register of members of the Company will be closed from Thursday, 11 December 2025 to Monday, 15 December 2025, both days inclusive if the final dividend for the year ended 30 June 2025 was approved at the Annual General Meeting. During such period no transfer of shares will be effected.
