INTRODUCTION

This circular includes information required by the Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the "Stock Exchange") to be given to shareholders concerning (1) the re-election of retiring Directors; and (2) the proposed general mandates for the issue of shares and repurchase of fully-paid shares to be granted to the Directors of the Company to be approved by shareholders at the annual general meeting of the Company to be held on 24 August 2009 (the "AGM").

RE-ELECTION OF RETIRING DIRECTORS

Pursuant to Bye-law 98, at each annual general meeting, one-third of the Directors for the time being, or, if their number is not 3 or a multiple of 3, then the number nearest to one-third, shall retire from office by rotation provided that no Director holding office as Chairman shall be subject to retirement by rotation or be taken into account in determining the number of Directors to retire. The Directors to retire shall be those who have been longest in office since their last election. A retiring Director shall be eligible for re-election.

Accordingly, Mr. Wong Tin Cheung (Mr. Wong) and Mr. So Yau Chi (Mr. So) shall retire at the AGM who shall then be eligible for re-election. Brief biographical details of the retiring Directors are set out below.

Mr. Wong Tin Cheung, JP, aged 45, is the Vice Chairman of the Group, Managing Director of Yau Lee Construction Company Limited ("Yau Lee Construction") and Yau Lee Wah Concrete Precast Products Limited, Vice Chairman of REC Engineering Company Limited as well as Chief Executive Officer of VHSoft Technologies Company Limited. Having earned his Bachelor Degree in Civil Engineering at the University of Southampton, Master Degree in Foundation Engineering at the University of Birmingham and Master Degree in Business Administration at the Chinese University of Hong Kong, he has been taking an active role in Hong Kong construction industry for more than a decade.

Mr. Wong is appointed as the Member of Construction Industry Council, the Member of the Occupational Safety and Health Council, the Member of MPF Industry Schemes Committee, the Member of the Land and Development Advisory Committee, the President of the Hong Kong Construction Association and the Chairman of Pneumoconiosis Compensation Fund Board and the First Vice President of International Federation of Asia and Western Pacific Contractors' Associations as well as an Adjunct Professor in the Department of Building and Real Estate of the Hong Kong Polytechnic University. He won the "2001 Hong Kong Outstanding Young Digi Persons Award" and the "Bauhinia Cup Outstanding Entrepreneur Award 2002" presented by the Hong Kong Polytechnic University. He is a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Building. In 2009, he became an Honorary Fellow of University of Central Lancashire.

Mr. Wong was elected member of 2006 Election Committee Subsection Election (Real Estate & Construction) and the Member of Guizhou Province Committee of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference. In 2008, Mr. Wong was appointed as a Justice of the Peace(JP) by the Government of the HKSAR.

Mr. Wong is the son of Mr. Wong Ip Kuen, an Executive Director and Chairman of the Company. He has no interest in the shares of the Company within the meaning of Part XV of the Securities and Futures Ordinance. Mr. Wong is entitled to a basic salary of HK\$2,015,000 per annum plus a discretionary bonus payment subject to the absolute discretion of the Board of Directors with regard to his performance and the results of the Group. His remuneration package is determined by reference to operating performance, market conditions and job responsibilities. Mr. Wong does not hold any directorship in any listed company in the last three years.

Mr. So Yau Chi, aged 65, joined the Group in 1994 as the General Manager of Yau Lee Construction and was appointed as a Director of the Group in 1996. He is responsible for the overall management of Yau Lee Construction. Before joining the Group, he worked in the Housing Department for over 17 years and held the post of Senior Structural Engineer before he left. Mr. So is a Fellow member of the Institution of Structural Engineers in the United Kingdom and was the Vice President of the Hong Kong Institution of Engineers for the 1994/95 sessions.

Mr. So has no interest in the shares of the Company within the meaning of Part XV of the Securities and Futures Ordinance. Mr. So is entitled to basic salary of HK\$1,758,000 per annum plus a discretionary bonus payment subject to the absolute discretion of the Board of Directors with regard to his performance and the results of the Group. His remuneration package is determined by reference to operating performance, market conditions and job responsibilities. Mr. So does not hold any directorship in any listed company in the last three years.

As far as the Directors are aware, there are no other matters which are required to be brought to the attention of the Shareholders of the Company and there is no information relating to the above Directors which is required to be disclosed pursuant to any of the requirements of Rule 13.51(2)(h) to (v) of the Rules Governing the Listing Securities on the Stock Exchange (the "Listing Rules").

EXERCISE OF THE SHARE ISSUE MANDATE

Resolution No. 5(1) set out in the notice of AGM (the "AGM Notice") dated 24 July 2009 will, if passed, give a general unconditional mandate (the "Share Issue Mandate") to the Directors authorising the exercise by the Directors of the powers of the Company to allot additional shares of HK\$0.20 each in the capital of the Company ("Shares"). Subject to certain exceptions as set out in the AGM Notice, the additional shares alloted shall not in aggregate exceed 20% of the nominal amount of the share capital of the Company in issue at the date of the AGM (i.e. not exceeding 87,610,720 shares based on the issued share capital of the Company of 438,053,600 shares as at the Latest Practicable Date and assuming that such issued share capital remains the same as at the date of passing the resolution) and may be exercised at any time during the Relevant Period (as defined in Resolution No. 5(1) set out in the AGM Notice).

EXERCISE OF THE REPURCHASE MANDATE

Resolutions No. 5(2) and 5(3) set out in the AGM Notice will, if passed, give a general unconditional mandate (the "**Repurchase Mandate**") to the Directors authorising the repurchase by the Company of up to 10% of the fully paid Shares in issue at the date of the AGM at any time during the Relevant Period (as defined in Resolution No. 5(2) set out in the AGM Notice).

The Directors believe that these proposals, which are similar to those approved by shareholders in previous years, will provide the Board with a prudent measure of flexibility for them to act in the Company's interests. The information set out below constitutes an Explanatory Statement (as defined in Rule 10.06 of the Listing Rules) for the purpose of the Listing Rules:—

(1) Share Capital

Exercise in full of the Repurchase Mandate (on the basis of 438,053,600 Shares in issue as at 23 July 2009, being the latest practicable date (the "Latest Practicable Date") prior to the printing of this circular) would result in up to 43,805,360 Shares being repurchased by the Company during the Relevant Period as defined in Resolution No. 5(2).

(2) Reasons for Repurchases

The Directors believe that it is in the best interests of the Company and its shareholders to have a general authority from shareholders to enable the Directors to repurchase Shares. Such repurchases may, depending on market conditions and funding arrangements at the time, lead to an enhancement in the value of the Shares and/or earnings per Share and will only be made when the Directors believe that such repurchases will benefit the Company and its shareholders.

(3) Funding of Repurchases

In repurchasing Shares, the Company may only apply funds legally available for such purpose in accordance with the laws of Bermuda and the Memorandum of Association and Bye-laws of the Company. Such funds may include profits available for distribution and the proceeds of a fresh issue of Shares made for the purpose of the repurchases.

There might be an adverse impact on the working capital requirements or gearing levels of the Company (as compared with the position disclosed in the annual report of the Company for the year ended 31 March 2009 in the event that the Repurchase Mandate is exercised in full at any time during the Relevant Period (as defined in Resolution No. 5(2)). However, the Directors do not propose to exercise the Repurchase Mandate to such an extent as would, in the circumstances, have a material adverse effect on the working capital requirements of the Company or the gearing levels which in the opinion of the Directors are from time to time appropriate for the Company.

(4) Share Price

(5) Disclosure of Interests

None of the Directors nor, to the best of their knowledge having made all reasonable enquiries, any of their associates (as defined in the Listing Rules) currently intends to sell any Shares to the Company or its subsidiaries under the Repurchase Mandate if such Repurchase Mandate is approved by shareholders.

The Directors have undertaken to the Stock Exchange that, so far as the same may be applicable, they will exercise the Repurchase Mandate in accordance with the Listing Rules and the laws of Bermuda.

No connected persons (as defined in the Listing Rules) have notified the Company that they have a present intention to sell Shares to the Company, or have undertaken not to do so, in the event that the Repurchase Mandate is approved by shareholders.

(6) Hong Kong Code on Takeovers and Mergers

If as a result of a repurchase of Shares by the Company, a shareholder's proportionate interest in the voting rights of the Company increases, such increase will be treated as an acquisition for the purpose of the Hong Kong Code on Takeovers and Mergers (the "Code"). Accordingly, a shareholder, or a group of shareholders acting in concert, could obtain or consolidate control of the Company and become obliged to make a mandatory offer in accordance with Rule 26 of the Code. All Fine Investment Company Limited and Billion Goal Holdings Limited hold 230,679,599 Shares and 5,404,000 shares respectively, representing approximately 53.89% of the issued share capital of the Company as at the Latest Practicable Date. Mr. Wong Ip Kuen, a Director of the Company, owns the entire issued share capital of All Fine Investment Company Limited and Billion Goal Holdings Limited. The Directors are not aware of any such consequences which would arise under the Code as a consequence of any purchase pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate. In the event that any exercise of the Repurchase Mandate would, to the knowledge of the Directors, have such a consequence, the Directors would not exercise the mandate to such an extent.

In addition, assuming that the Repurchase Mandate is exercised in full, the share capital of the Company in issue will be reduced to 394,248,240 Shares (on the basis of 438,053,600 Shares in issue as at the Latest Practicable Date). Mr. Wong Ip Kuen, through All Fine Investment Company Limited and Billion Goal Holdings Limited, will hold 236,083,599 Shares, representing approximately 59.88% of the issued share capital of the Company after the exercise of the Repurchase Mandate in full. As far as the Directors are aware, the full exercise of the Repurchase Mandate will not have any impact on the relevant minimum public shareholding requirements as stipulated in the Listing Rules.

(7) Repurchases made by the Company

The Company has not repurchased Shares (whether on the Stock Exchange or otherwise) in the six months up to the Latest Practicable Date.

VOTING BY POLL

Under Rule 13.39(4) of the Listing Rules, any vote of shareholders at a general meeting must be taken by poll. Accordingly, the ordinary resolutions proposed at the Annual General Meeting will also be taken by poll. A poll results announcement will be made by the Company after the Annual General Meeting in accordance with Rule 13.39(5) of the Listing Rules.

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The AGM Notice is set out on pages 8 to 11 of this circular. A form of proxy for use at the AGM is despatched with this circular. If you do not intend to be present at the AGM, you are requested to complete the form of proxy and return it to the Company's principal place of business in accordance with the instructions printed thereon not less than 48 hours before the time fixed for holding the AGM. Completion and deposit of the form of proxy will not preclude you from attending and voting at the AGM if you so wish.

RECOMMENDATION

The Directors believe that the re-election of the retiring Directors, the Share Issue Mandate and the Repurchase Mandate are in the interests of the Company and the shareholders of the Company as a whole. Accordingly, the Directors recommend that all shareholders should vote in favour of the relevant Resolutions to be proposed at the AGM.
